When the dentist takes a tooth picture

Sometimes the dentist takes a **picture of my teeth**.

This is called an **x-ray**. It shows the **inside of my mouth**, like a **secret picture** that helps the dentist see **what's happening**. The **picture doesn't hurt** — it's just a way to help keep my teeth **strong**.

- Child can **describe feelings** (quiet, still, curious).
