Questions You Might Have

What is laundry detergent made of?

Laundry detergent is a mix of cleaning agents, softeners, and stabilisers that help remove dirt and protect fabrics. These ingredients work together to clean clothes effectively.

What do builders and softeners do in detergent?

Builders help surfactants work better in hard water, and softeners protect fabrics during washing. These ingredients enhance cleaning performance and maintain fabric quality.

Is laundry detergent safe around children?

Laundry detergent should be stored safely away from children and used according to label instructions. Choose products designed for sensitive skin if family members have allergies or sensitivities.

Builders & Softeners



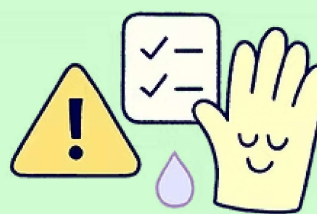
Builders help soap clean better, & softeners keep clothes gentle.
